HOW IT WORKS

Guaranteed Rent

A Supportive Housing Agency client becomes your tenant and pays 30 percent or more of his or her income towards rent; the service agency pays the remainder.

Case Management

Tenants receive regular in-home visits by case workers who ensure the new tenant is being responsible, such as paying bills on time and housekeeping, and successful in the new housing.

Housing Liaison

If there is a concern, problem or outstanding rent issue that isn't being resolved, the landlord can call a neutral individual – a housing liaison -- to help problem solve.

Tenant Education

The Supportive Housing Agency continues providing its clients ongoing education about tenancy and housing to ensure continued success once housed.
